## Local photographers feature on welcome signs

A tree kangaroo perched among leaves and a serene calm day at Weary Bay have been chosen as the winning images for a Cook Shire Council photography competition.

Council ran a photograph competition earlier this year to find local images for roadside welcome signs on the outskirts of Ayton, just south of Cooktown.

The tree kangaroo, snapped by Bloomfield locals Sigang and Mike McGough, will feature at the southern entrance to Ayton, while fellow local Ben Tome's shot of Weary Bay will feature on the northern entry sign. The winning images were chosen by the Bloomfield Ratepayers and Residents Association, and the winners will receive a \$200 Ayton IGA voucher, and also have their photographs framed and displayed at the Ayton Library.

The signs will be installed later this year.
