## New filter lining to keep water pristine

Relining and new filters recently installed at the Annan Water Treatment Plant will ensure Cooktown's town water remains among the best in the State.

The project was completed last month, and involved cleaning the filters, stripping the old lining off, relining and re filling the filters with sand and anthracite. "The filter media generally has a life of 10 years," Cook Shire Council Water and Wastewater Manager Robyn Maddalena said. "The sand and anthracite was replaced to ensure ongoing compliance with the Australian Drinking Water Guidelines and a continued supply of clean, clear, pristine water – made fresh daily!"
