Section 4 - Terms and conditions

The pig trap will be loaned to the applicant subject to the following terms and conditions

1. The applicant agrees to provide Cook Shire Council details of all feral pigs trapped using the Council supplied trap using an approved form. The applicant further agrees to submit these details weekly.
2. The trap is only to be used for the control of feral pigs, as a declared pest animal in accordance with the *Land Protection (Pest and Stock Route Management) Act 2002*.
3. In circumstances where the applicant is required to euthanase feral pigs caught in the trap the applicant agrees to adhere to the guidelines outlines in the *Primary Industries Standing Committee Model Code of Practice for the Welfare of Animals Pigs* (www.publish.csiro.au/Books/download.cfm?ID=5698)
4. The applicant agrees to return the trap in good condition.
5. The applicant agrees that if the trap is damaged or lost, to pay for the repairs or the sum of the replacement of the trap.
6. The applicant releases the Council from any claim which it might otherwise have against the Council on any account whatsoever by, through or in connection with the supply of the trap by Council or the use of the trap by the applicant, and the applicant indemnifies the Council against any such claim which might be made against the Council by a third party.
7. The applicant acknowledges that, in setting and otherwise using the trap, and in dealing with any trapped animal, the applicant does not act as agent of the Council or under any authority conferred by the Council.
8. Without limiting or affecting any other provision of this agreement, the applicant acknowledges that Cook Shire Council has supplied the trap on the specific basis that the applicant will not use the trap or otherwise deal with any trapped animal in contravention of any provision of the *Animal Care and Protection Act 2001*, Criminal Code or other relevant law, and the owner understands that he or she may be subject to criminal

penalties if he or she breaches any provision of that Act.

The applicant also acknowledges that he or she may incur civil liability if he or she injures or destroys an animal which is the property of some other person, and that, as set out above, the applicant alone will bear any such liability (as well as being required to indemnify the Council in respect of any claim made against Council by the owner of such animal). The applicant has been advised that the only way to be sure of avoiding such liability exposed is to treat all trapped animal humanely and in accordance with the laws mentioned above.
- 10. The applicant grants Cook Shire Council personnel the right to access the land on which the trap is located to retrieve the trap.
