Work to start on waterfront irrigation

The grass will soon be greener at the Cooktown waterfront development, with the next stage of works to start in early October.

Following the allocation of funds in this year's budget, Council put the design, supply and installation of an irrigation system at the site out to tender. Think Water Cairns was last month awarded the tender, and work will start in the first week of October. The project is expected to take about two months, with the site remaining open to the public during the work. Areas will be barricaded for safety as needed, and visitors to the site are asked to be aware of signage during the construction.

The Cooktown waterfront development was opened to the public in June, and includes parkland, barbecues, fishing platforms, exercise stations, a kiosk and amenities and a water park. The site will be officially opened with a gala community event on Saturday, November 17.
