Conditions of entry to compete

1. An entry fee of \$5 for adults and \$2 for juniors (16 years and under or student) and concessions per entry, with entrants putting more than three entries in, fees will be capped at \$15 for adults and \$6 for juniors and concessions.
2. In classes where a variety of exhibits may be accepted, a separate class may be set up if 5 or more entries of the same kind are included.
3. All Baking to be home baked – not packet mix or purchased.
4. All exhibits including perishables are to be benched for judging prior to 10am Monday 22nd October, 2007 for judging to commence. (Doors open to exhibitors from 8am)
5. At the conclusion of the day, exhibits are to be collected after 4pm.
6. Judges decision is final.

Exhibitors are responsible for removal of own exhibits unless being sold or donated
