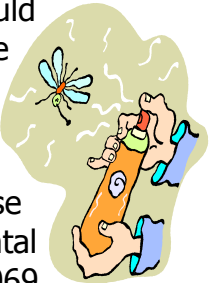

Cooktown Dengue Mosquito Survey

Cook Shire Officers have surveyed over 80% of the Cooktown's populated area as demarcated by its authorised inspection program. Council is pleased to announce that the mosquito population surveyed in residential areas appear to be relatively low. However, it is worth noting that the results from larvae sampling confirmed that the dengue mosquito exists in Cooktown. This means that all resident should keep up the effort to eliminate mosquito breeding ground from their premises.
