

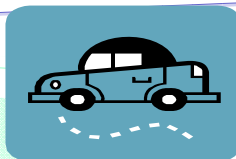

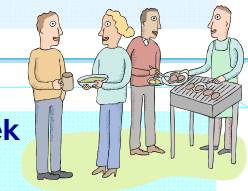
Cook Shire Agricultural Show Day Coming Soon!

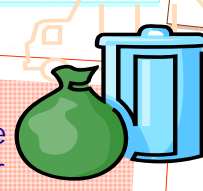

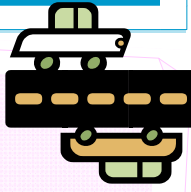

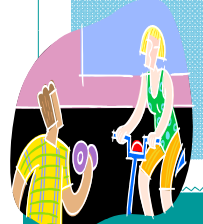
Gym is Now Open, Bookings are essential
