For the past 12 months, key community members and school representatives have been working with the DCI team to co-design a master plan and identify key projects for the Coen Kindergarten and Coen campus.

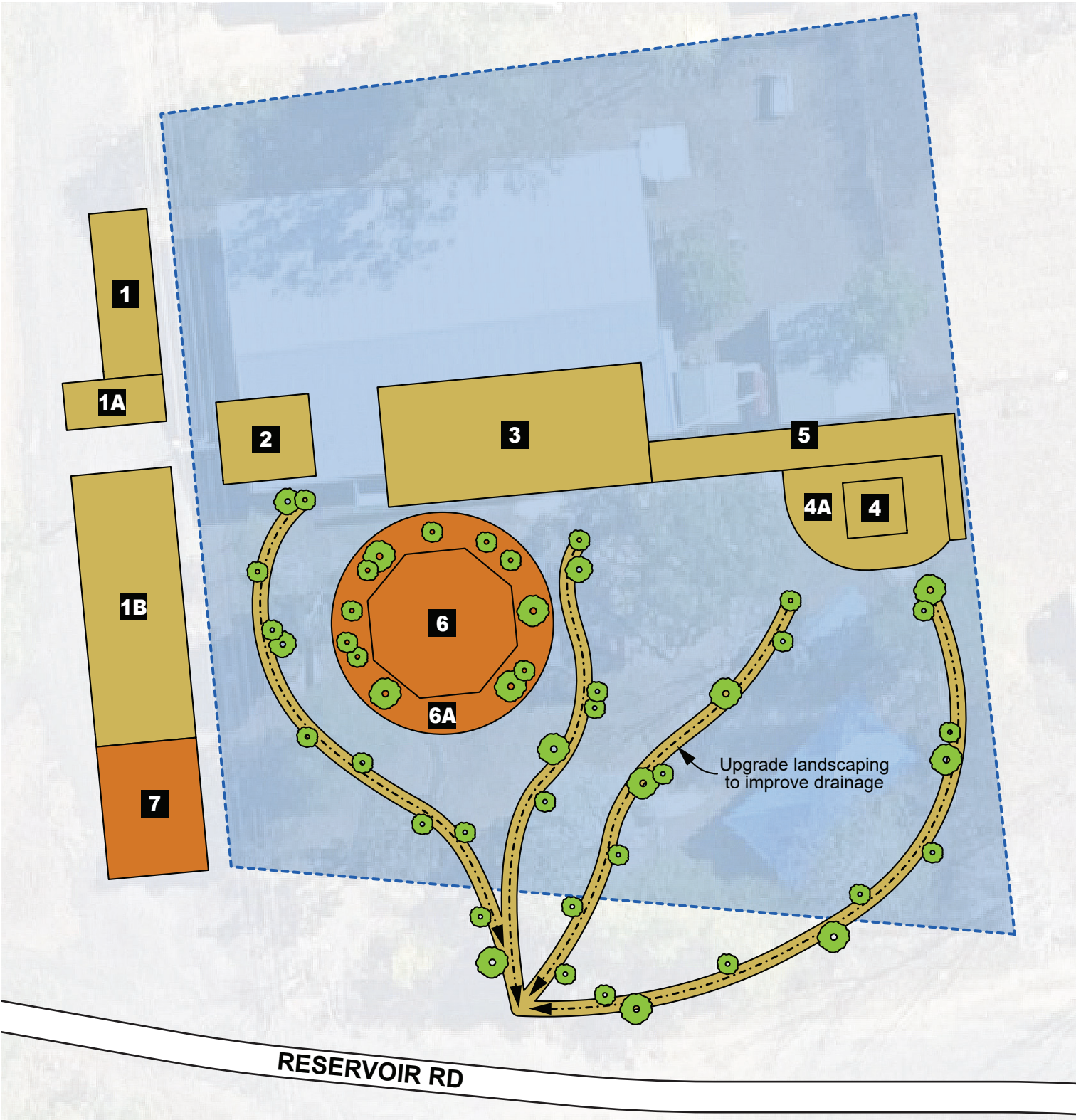
Next steps:

- 1B** New parking/drop and go

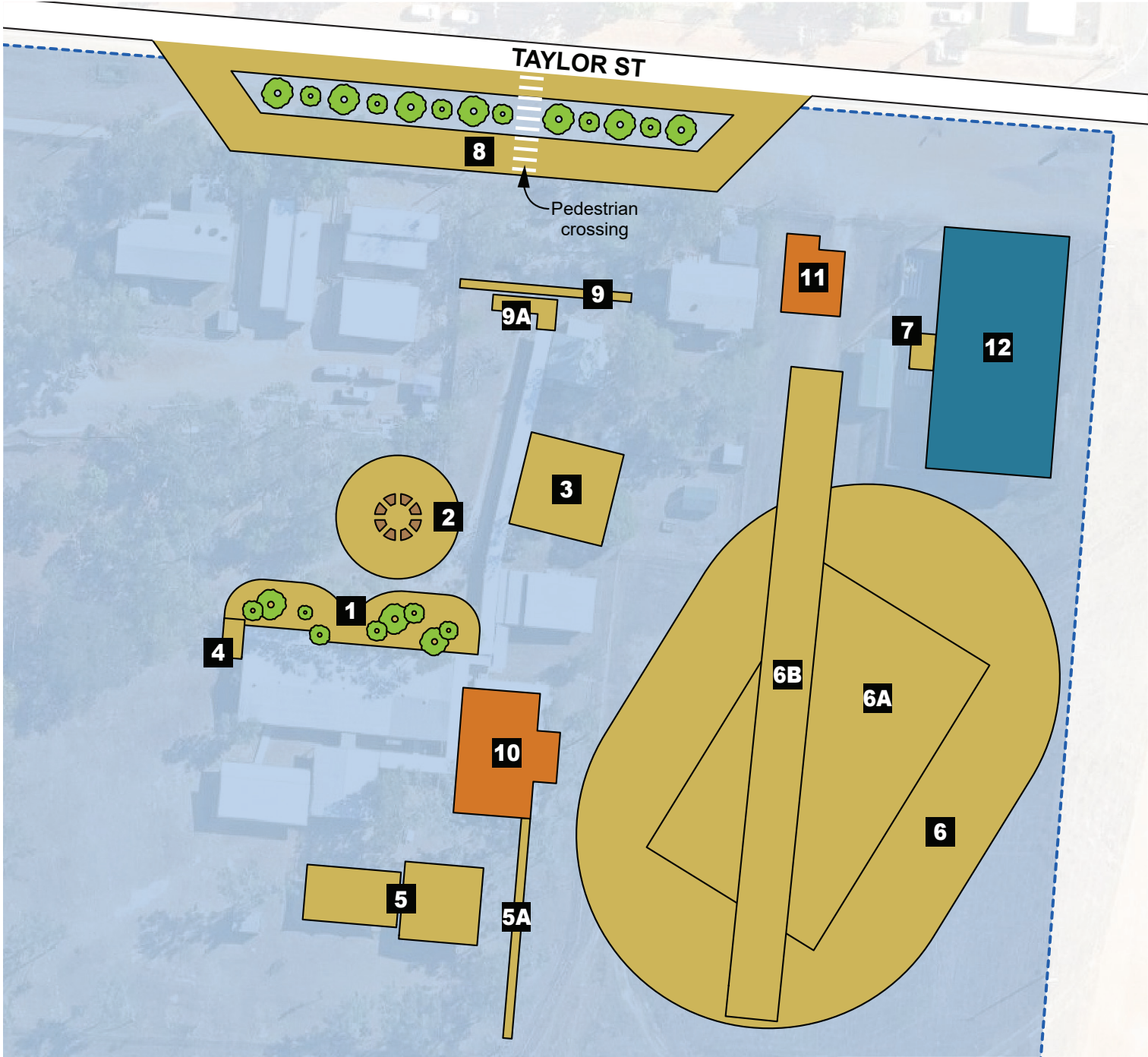
- 2** New reception with secure entry and exit
