

## Councillor Code of Conduct Register (July 2022 to June 2023)

Local Government Act 2009 Sections 150DX, 150DY, 150DZ

As of May 2018, Local Governments are required to keep and publish a Councillor Code of Conduct Register detailing orders made about unsuitable meeting conduct of councillors, decisions relating to suspected inapropriate conduct, dismissed complaints about the conduct of a councillor, and matters investigated about councillor conduct taken no further.
