

02: OLD QUARRY WALK

This recently rediscovered feature was identified by satellite imagery. It is the site of a quarry where stone was excavated for building in Cooktown and possibly in the gardens. It shows examples of the historical techniques used to extract the stone and is of historical and cultural significance. While its age and usage details are unclear at this time, it is recommended that an archaeological survey be undertaken to establish its history. As a feature I could add historical and cultural value to the CGB and provide value to the CGB experience. It is proposed that a new track be built to access it from the existing walking track to Finch Bay.
