

## 08: FOUNTAIN PERGOLA

This feature includes a semi circular paved area using the local stone to match existing stone work with a arbor or pergola over, orientated towards the Old Fountain. It would provide seating and shade and would allow for extended views across the fountain to the heritage tree collection. It could also be used for weddings, or other celebrations and may also include a new path system to access the feature from the primary path system. This area also provides a major visual access point for the central part of the gardens.

It is important to stress that it is intended that the structure would not damage or detract from the fountain, but would instead frame it and be complementary to it. It must also be noted that as the fountain is part of the heritage listed features of the CBG, any proposal will need to gain Queensland Government approval prior to construction.

During development of this feature it is anticipated that remedial work would be undertaken to return the fountain to it's original working condition.
