## 09: PERFORMANCE STAGE / SHELTER

This feature would serve as a shelter for visitors to rest and enjoy the views and could also provide a stage for various musical or artistic performances. It would be orientated towards the lawn opposite, which is slightly sloped and creates an natural amphitheatre. It would include a timber deck performance area (the example below is 5m x 5m) and also would include an open sided roof to provide shade and cover from rain. Services, like power and water would also be supplied along with some basic storage and seating. It is envisaged that primary path would pass through the structure. During performances access around the stage is already provided with the secondary path that loops behind this area. The shelter could also include some interpretive signage displaying aspects of the botanical collection and/or details about the history of the gardens.
