## Fundraiser pavers installed at waterfront

Almost 500 pavers inscribed with names and messages will be installed at the Cooktown waterfront development site this week.

The pavers were a joint fundraising initiative by Cook Shire Council, the Cooktown Amateur Turf Club, Cooktown District Community Centre, Cooktown Full Boar Thai Boxing Club, Endeavour Family Daycare, Our CDF Inc and the Cooktown Re-enactment Association. Residents, businesses, visitors and even family pets have their names and special messages engraved on the bricks, which will be laid along the edges of two pathways across the waterfront parklands.

The Cooktown waterfront project will include a children's water park, exercise equipment, kiosk, viewing platform, barbecues, fishing platforms and parklands on reclaimed land at Webber Esplanade. The project is funded by the Queensland Government and Cook Shire Council.
