Cooktown Pool open after major upgrade

The Cooktown Pool has re-opened following the biggest upgrade since it opened in 1992.

The pool was closed and completely emptied while new tiles, painting, drainage pipes, a change room upgrade, office re-fit and storage extension were underway. "The pool was reopened on Monday morning and is looking amazing," Cook Shire Council Community, Economy and Innovation Director Lawrence Booth said. "The project highlighted the positive working relationship Council has with Cooktown State School and Education Queensland," Mr Booth said. "The pool is owned by Education Queensland and managed by Council, with major works such as this upgrade carried out by Education Queensland contractors. The pool is nearly 30 years old, but thanks to Education Queensland it now has a new lease on life and is ready for the community to enjoy again."
