And if you just want to be a spectator, sit back and enjoy the show, with the parade being led by the ever-popular 1RAR Rising Suns Army big band.

While most events are free to enjoy, there are a handful of ticketed events, including Riverbend Cruises, the botanical drawing workshop and Poet's Breakfast, which are booking out fast.
