A host of Council statistics and information is available in two new reports, both adopted at the October Council meeting.

The 2018-19 Annual Report showcases Council's financial and operational progress against Cook Shire's 2017-22 Corporate Plan and annual Operational Plan. "The Annual Report is not just a legal requirement, it is a great tool for people to review Council's progress in an easyto-read format," Cook Shire Council Chief Executive Officer Linda Cardew said.

Council's first quarterly Council in Focus report was also adopted at the October meeting, providing an informative summary of some of Council's key performance indicators from July to September. "This is the first time we have presented this information as a quarterly report," Ms Cardew said. "It provides both statistics across a range of performance indicators and a pictorial report which provides insight into some of Council's recent operational works.
