Cook Shire's Got Talent – Terms and Conditions.

Who can apply?

Applications for Cook Shire's Got Talent are open to all young people aged 7-18 years, currently residing in Cook Shire.

What consent will I require to participate?

All participants aged under 18 years of age, must obtain parent/guardian consent to participate in Cook Shire's Got Talent, on application please email your application and consent forms to mail@cook.qld.gov.au to secure a spot or drop into council reception between 8:45am and 4:45pm Monday to Friday.

How do I apply?

Applications for Cook Shire's Got Talent can be made by completing an application form online via Cook Shire Council website, by emailing **mail@cook.qld.gov.au** or at reception PCYC & Cook Shire Council.

There is a \$5.00 registration fee per child per act with fees to be paid when lodging the registration application. Registration fees are not refundable should you or your child decide they no-longer want to participate.

- Applications open from 4-22 April 2024 and close at 5pm.
- No late entrants will be accepted after 22 April at 5pm.

Assessment criteria

If an act has more than one person that performs in it, the act will be allocated to the age bracket of the **ELDEST** child in that group.

A child cannot be in more than **TWO** performances in total.

All performances must be PG rated with no offensive content, as this is a family friendly event.

Approval and notification

Cook Shire Council will notify applicants by email or phone that their application has been received.

Will I get paid for the performance?

Applicants will not be paid for their performance at Cook Shire's Got Talent. This is a voluntary performance.

What do I need to bring with me to the performance?

Applicants must supply their own equipment such as musical instruments and costumes.

All performers under the age of 18, must be accompanied by a parent or guardian for the duration of the event and not left with siblings or other family members and friends – your child is your responsibility.

What time do I need to attend and where is the performance located?

Cook Shire's Got Talent will be held at the PCYC Cooktown on Thursday, 13 June 2024. Doors open at 5.30pm for a 6.00pm start and the event will finish at 9pm.



Performers must be available between 5.30pm and 9pm on 13 June 2024 at the PCYC Cooktown.

Performers will need to rehearse in their own time either at;

Will there be dress rehearsals?

There will be two evenings allocated for dress rehearsals on Friday, 31 May and Friday, 7 June from 3-6pm. Please note; that due to other commitments Lighting and PA staff may not be available on these afternoons.

What happens to the consent form once it is filled out?

The consent form is retained by Cook Shire Council. If requested, a photocopy of the form will be made available to the participant and/or the parent/guardian.
