

PUBLIC CONSULTATION ON PROPOSED NEW LOCAL LAW

Cook Shire Council ("Council") has resolved to make a new Local Law, being Local Law No. 6 (Waste Management) 2018 ("Proposed New Local Law"). The objective of this local law is to protect the public health, safety and amenity related to waste management by; regulating the storage, servicing and removal of waste; regulating the disposal of waste at waste facilities; and ensuring that an act or omission does not result in human injury, property damage or environmental harm.

Council invites the public to comment on the Proposed New Local Law, including any anti-competitive provisions.
