

Cooktown: Level Three WATER RESTRICTIONS

WEDNESDAY, JULY 25 TO FRIDAY, JULY 27

Due to infrastructure replacement, Cooktown's water supply will temporarily be limited during this time. To ensure everyone has adequate water, we request that those on the town water supply abide by Level Three water restrictions.

WHAT DO LEVEL 3 RESTRICTIONS MEAN?

- Gardens can only be watered with a watering can or bucket between 7pm and 9pm
- Lawns can NOT be watered at all
- Washing of vehicles, hosing paved areas etc is NOT permitted
- Swimming pools must NOT be topped up
- Mobile water tankers must NOT be filled except when supplying water for domestic firefighting

COUNCIL SERVICE CHANGES

Council will not be watering public spaces during this period, however the Cooktown Swimming Pool and Cooktown Water Park on the waterfront will remain open.
