One submissions was received during the public notification period of this application. The matters raised by this submission and Council's consideratin of the matters in making this decision are summarised

as:

1. The submitter requested that the facility be made available to phones serviced by all mobile phone companies, and capable of providing fixed NBN wireless signals. The grounds raised in this submissions are not factors under Council's control or jurisdiction and cannot be enforced or regulated by Council or local government.

Reasons for the Decision

Cook Shire Council approved in full with conditions as it complied with the applicable assessment benchmarks. In particular:

- An assessment was made against the Cook Shire Planning Scheme 2017, the applicable assessment benchmarks ad the State Planning Policy (SPP), and demonstrated compliance;
- The Telecommunications Facility is essential community infrastructure that will service the south Cooktown area;
