MAJOR AMENDMENT 2.0 TO COOK SHIRE COUNCIL PLANNING SCHEME 2017

Notice is given under section 18 of the *Planning Act 2016* that on 20 February 2019, Cook Shire Council resolved to adopt the Proposed Major Amendment 2 to the Cook Shire Council Planning Scheme 2017 (the proposed amendment).

On 3 June 2019, the Minister from Department of State Development, Manufacturing, Infrastructure and Planning endorsed the proposed amendment advising Council that it may now proceed to public consultation of the proposed amendments. Public consultation is between July 17, 2019 and August 13, 2019.

The purpose and general effect of the proposed amendment includes policy changes, i.e. a review of the Reconfiguring a Lot Code, the incorporation of a Local Plan for Lakeland into the Planning Scheme, and more, to the Cook Shire Council Planning Scheme 2017.

A copy of the amended Cook Shire Council Planning Scheme is available on Council's website www.cook.qld.gov.au/council/community-engagement or for inspection or purchase at Cook Shire Council's Customer Service Centre, located at 10 Furneaux Street, Cooktown.

Submissions about any aspect of the proposed amendment may be made to Cook Shire Council by any person. A properly made submission must be:

- written and signed by each person making the submission,
- be received on or before August 13, 2019,
- state the name and residential or business address of all submission-makers
- state its grounds, and the facts and circumstances relied on to support the grounds
- state one postal or electronic address for service
