How our services have changed

To help prevent the spread of coronavirus in Cook Shire and in line with Government rules, Council has made changes to some of our services, including closing facilities, limiting public interaction and moving other services online.

CLOSED

Cooktown Swimming Pool

The Cooktown Pool is closed until further notice. Our pool staff have been re-deployed in other areas of Council.

Cooktown Water Park

The Cooktown Water Park is closed and the water has been turned off.

Outdoor gyms and playgrounds

The gym equipment on the Cooktown foreshore must not be used. All Cook Shire playgrounds are also closed.

Cook Shire libraries

The Cooktown and Bloomfield libraries are closed, but online services are still available. Our library staff are available to answer calls and emails, and some programs such as Interactive Storytime have moved online. Visit our website for details.
