



Proposal for Temporary Use of the Marton Boat Ramp

This leaflet contains information about the initial proposal to temporarily use the Marton boat ramp as a barge landing site to unload wind turbine components for transport to the Lakeland Wind Farm project.

Initial Proposal



Wind turbine components will arrive into Cairns. The blades will be transported directly from Cairns by road.



The heavy components will be transferred onto a barge and shipped to the Marton Boat Ramp.



The Marton boat ramp will need to have its rock wall removed temporarily to allow the barge to land. Once we are finished it will be replaced.

Barge Logistical Details

Number of Loads	1 barge load maximum per day depending on weather and tides (high tide predominantly), roughly 3-5 per week.
Boat Ramp Occupation	The ramp is likely to be occupied for 4-6 hours at a time.
Length of Barge Activity	5 – 6 months
